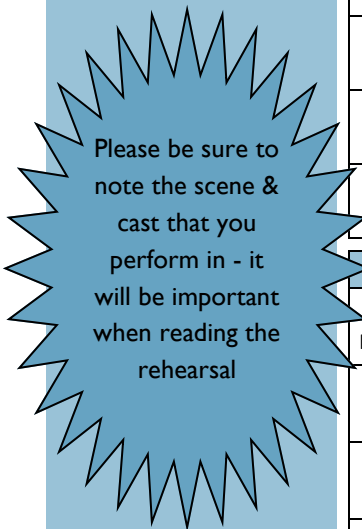



THEATRE REHEARSALS AT HUMANITIES

Arrive in full costume with hair & make-up done and report directly to the theatre 15 minutes prior to the start of your cast/section rehearsal. Students will sit in the theatre seats to watch until they are called to the stage for their rehearsal. Parents are welcome to remain in the theatre and watch rehearsals - photo and recording devices are not permitted at rehearsals or on performance nights. Students who rehearse more than one piece on the same night should arrive in their first costume and bring additional costumes in a garment bag clearly labelled with their name. Students can leave garment bags and costumes in the change areas assigned - Levels 5A & Up in Downstairs changeroom; Primary & Junior Levels in Upstairs changeroom.

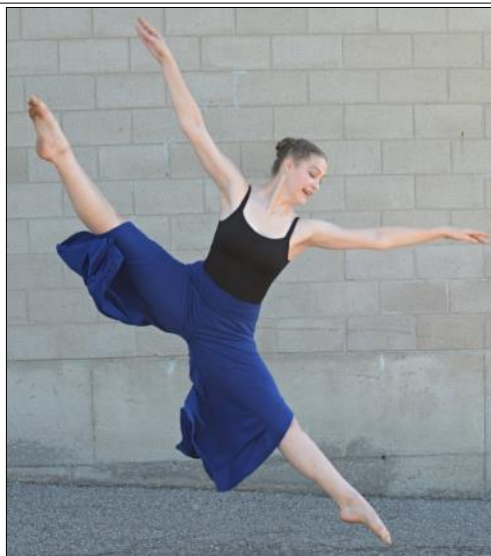

COSTUME INFORMATION

Costumes for the Spring Performance will be **distributed in class** and sent home with your child **during the period from April 22-28.**

There is a fee for costumes and students keep their costumes following the performance (unless otherwise noted). Students have already been charged a \$50.00 costume deposit for each of their costumes and the balance of fees owing **will be posted to your account on April 12th.** Costume fees are due on April 19th. Costume fees and all account balances must be **paid in full** before costumes are sent home with students.

You can pay for costumes on-line using a credit card, by e-transfer to admin@carouseldancecentre.ca or in person by cash, credit or debit. To make an on-line payment, please visit our website www.carouseldancecentre.ca and click on the MY ACCOUNT tab to login to your Carousel registration account.

If your child dances in more than one dance, we highly recommend purchasing a nude suit. A nude suit is a skin tone bodysuit that can be worn underneath all costumes and makes changing from one costume to the next much easier.

TICKET SALES

TICKETS GO ON SALE ON MONDAY, APRIL 15TH AT 12:00 NOON.

There are three options for purchasing tickets:

1) ON-LINE - The easiest way to purchase tickets is on-line. The link for on-line purchase will be e-mailed to families prior to April 15th. On-line ticket sales will commence at noon on Monday, April 15th and following this date, on-line tickets will be available to be purchased at any time of day or night. There is a \$2.26 per ticket convenience fee for tickets purchased on-line.

2) IN-PERSON - Tickets can be purchased in person from the ticket counter at the Humanities Theatre Box Office.

3) PHONE - Tickets can be purchased by phone 519-888-4908. There is a \$1.13 per ticket convenience fee for tickets purchased by phone.

TICKET PRICES:

Ticket prices are \$24.00 for adults and \$14.00 for children, students and seniors. Babes in arms (18 months & younger) do not require a ticket. A 10% box office surcharge as well as a \$1.50 per ticket CIF fee and 13% HST is added to the ticket prices making the final ticket price (before on-line and phone convenience fees) \$31.02 for adults and \$19.72 for children (age 13 and under). Ticket sales cover the cost of theatre rental. We have not increased ticket prices this year, even though our expenses continue to increase.

TICKETS FOR DANCERS:

You are not required to purchase a ticket for children who are performing, unless you want them to sit with you during the section of the show that they are not performing in.

- ★ The Box Office is located at the Humanities Theatre in Hagey Hall, University of Waterloo
- ★ The Box Office phone number is 519-888-4908
- ★ Box Office hours are noon to 5:00pm Monday to Friday and one hour before each performance
- ★ Ticket costs are \$24.00 adults & \$14.00 child (under 13)/senior (65+). *Please note there is a 10% box office surcharge, 13% HST & \$1.50 CIF added to all ticket prices at the time of sale.
- ★ The Box Office accepts Debit, Visa, Mastercard, AMEX, Visa Debit, MC Debit
- ★ Tickets are reserved seating
- ★ When purchasing tickets, there are 2 short term parking spaces (max. 15 minutes) available in the loading area.

PERFORMANCE DAYS

Arrival at the theatre . . .

Students should arrive a minimum of 30 minutes prior to the start of the performance.

Upon arrival at the theatre, signs will be posted with details of change room/dressing room assignment.

Parents must drop off and pick up students from their assigned room and all children, Junior 1 and below, must be signed in and out.

During the performance . . .

Before and after their time on stage, students will be supervised in classrooms at the Humanities Theatre.

There will be colouring pages and activities to keep the students occupied.

Preparing for Performance Day . . .

Hair - Hair must be worn neatly off the face, either in a bun or French braid. Bangs are acceptable for students in the primary and junior schools. All students in the intermediate and senior schools should gel/pin bangs back. Any specific hair requirements will be noted in our on-line costume document - please watch for links to the on-line costume document which will be sent during the last week in April.

Make-Up - Stage lights tend to wash out natural colouring and make students look pale. Therefore, stage make-up should be worn and each student is responsible for applying his or her own make-up.

Primary & Junior School (age 5-11)

Please do your child's make up at home. We suggest lipstick and blush.

Intermediate & Senior School (age 12+)

Please apply your own make-up - brown eye shadow, blush, lipstick, eye liner & mascara. Any specific make-up requirements will be stated by class teachers.

Jewelry - Jewelry should not be worn with the exception of small studded earrings that cannot be removed or jewelry that is required for religious, cultural or medical purposes.

Show Length

Currently, we anticipate the show will be 2 3/4 hours in length plus two 10 minute intermissions. You should expect your child to be finished performing approximately 3 hours following the start time of the performance. The show order is 1) Swan Lake 2) Beauty & the Beast 3) Rock
