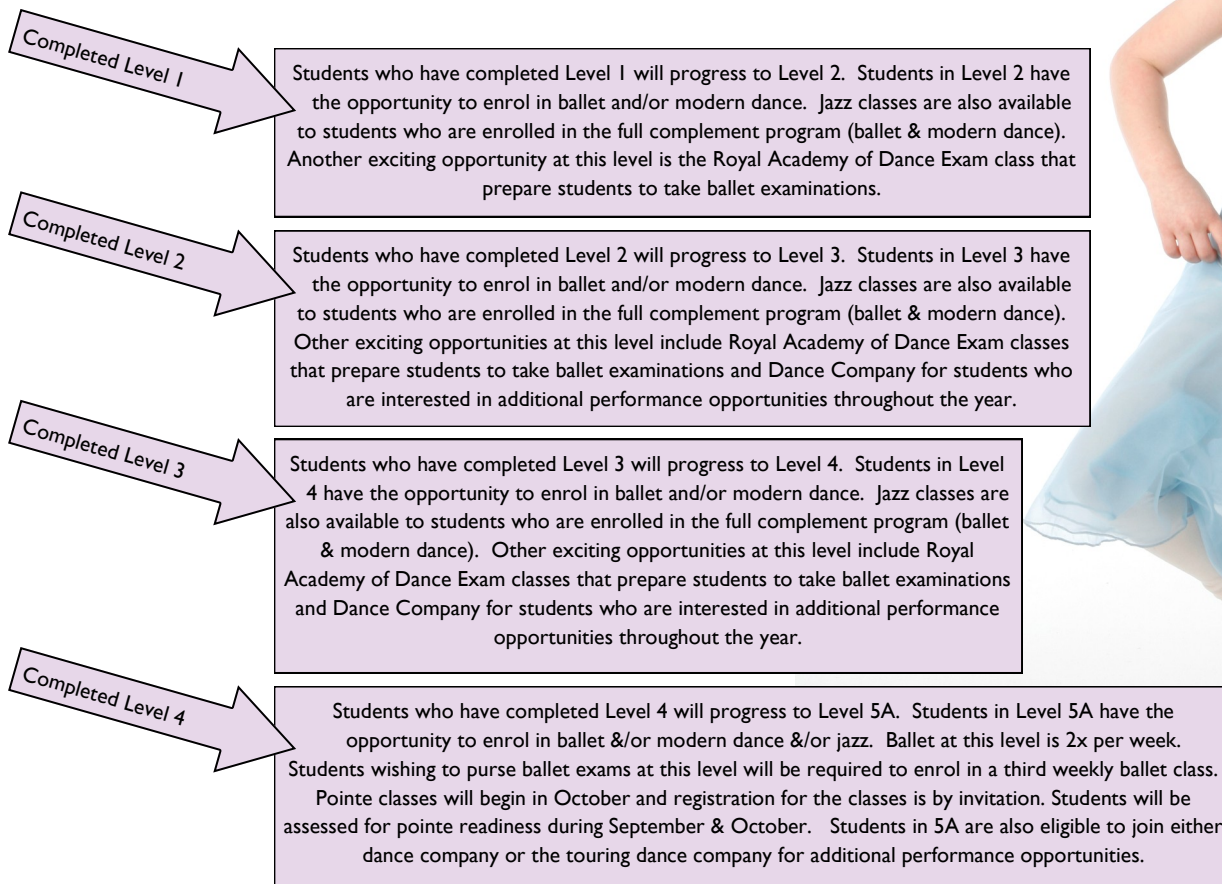
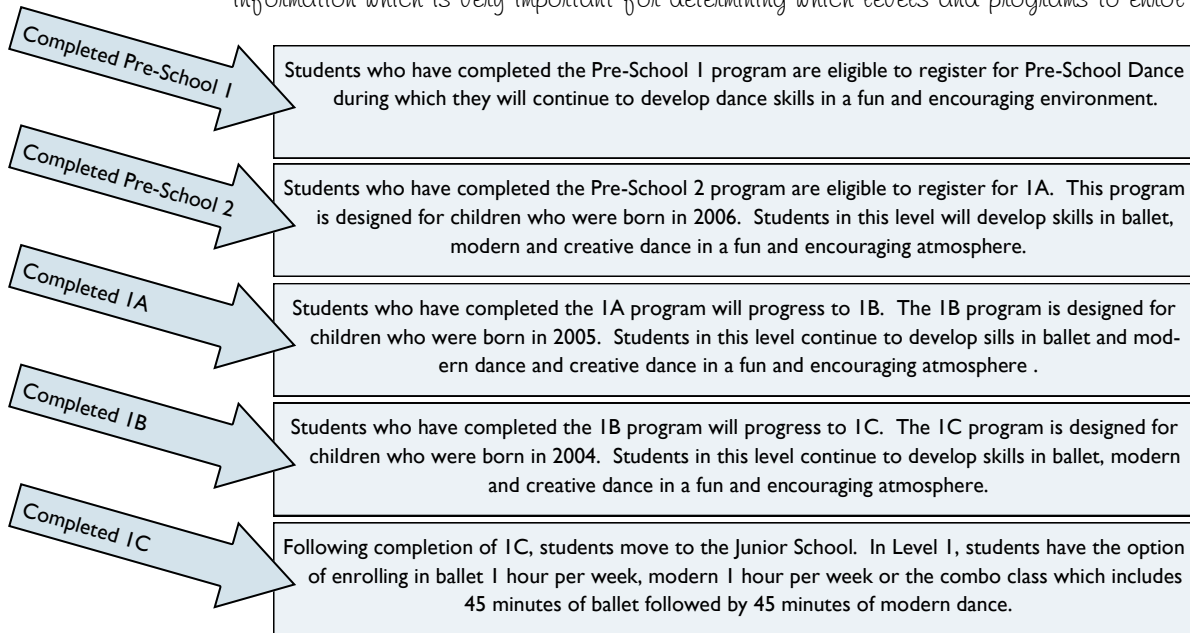


Carousel Dance Centre - Fall Registration 2011

The pre-registration period for students who were previously enrolled in a class at Carousel commences on June 6th at 9:30am. Registration is accepted on-line or in-person. Completed 5A

Students who have completed Level 5A are eligible to register for ballet, pointe, modern and/or jazz at the 5B level. In level 5B Ballet, students will learn the NEW RAD Intermediate Foundations syllabus which is being taught for the first time this fall. A weekly coaching class is offered for students at this level who choose to pursue an examination. Students at this level are also eligible to participate in Dance Company or Touring Company which provides the opportunity for extra performances throughout the year.

Completed 5B

Students who have completed 5B will progress to Level 6A. In Level 6A Ballet, students will begin to learn the NEW RAD Intermediate syllabus which is being taught for the first time this fall. There are three weekly ballet classes offered and students must enrol in a minimum of 2 classes per week at this level. The Intermediate syllabus requires 2 years of study and is taught in both 6A and 6B. Students in 6A may enrol in the Intermediate coaching classes to begin preparing for their examination or may choose to enrol in the coaching class during their 6B year. At the 6A level, creative dance is no longer a component of the modern dance curriculum. Instead, Composition is offered as a separate one hour weekly class and students who choose to enrol in this class, have the opportunity to learn how to choreograph and to use their creative talents to create works for both themselves and other dancers. Students wishing to register in more than 1 weekly modern classes, have the opportunity to enrol in Level 6/7/8 modern as their second weekly modern class. Students seeking additional performance opportunities have the option of joining dance company or touring dance company.

Completed 6A

Students who have completed 6A will progress to Level 6B and can enrol in ballet, modern dance, jazz and/or composition. This year's 6B ballet students will learn the NEW RAD Intermediate Syllabus which is being launched this summer and being taught for the first time this fall. Level 6A ballet is offered three times per week and students must enrol in a minimum of 2 ballet classes per week. Pointe class is also offered 2x per week and students may choose to enrol in one or two pointe classes per week. Composition classes, for students who are interested in learning about creating dance is offered on Saturdays and there is also a Level 6/7/8 modern class that students are eligible to enrol in as a 2nd weekly modern class.. Students seeking additional performance opportunities have the option of joining dance company or touring dance company.

Completed 6B

Students who have completed 6B Ballet progress to Level 7A and are eligible to register for ballet, modern dance, jazz, composition and dance company. Students have the opportunity to register for 2 or 3 weekly ballet classes at this level. Students will begin to work on the Advanced 1 RAD syllabus which is a two year course of study. Two weekly pointe classes are offered at this level and students have the option of enrolling in one or both classes. Students who are interested in taking a second weekly modern class can register in Level 6/7/8 modern which will be offered on Saturday afternoons.

Completed 7A

Students who have completed Level 7A progress to Level 7B where they have the opportunity to take ballet, pointe, modern dance, jazz, composition and dance company. Students must enrol in a minimum of 2 weekly ballet classes, but at this level, we strongly encourage taking 3 ballet classes per week. Students opting to add a third weekly class, can register for the Thursday class which is a 7B/8 ballet class and will begin to introduce some Advanced 2 work. Similarly, pointe at this level will also be offered 2x per week and the Thursday class can be taken as the 2nd weekly pointe class. Students who are interested in taking a 2nd weekly modern class can enrol in the Saturday Level 6/7/8 modern class.

Completed 7B

Students who have completed Level 7B progress to Level 8. We are pleased to offer an Advanced 2 Level class on Tuesday evenings. This is the highest level of RAD ballet. Students in level 8 also have the opportunity to enrol in pointe, modern dance, jazz and composition classes as well as dance company.
